#### WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A DISCIPLE OF JESUS?

## II. WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

Man has a natural desire to be their own \_\_\_\_\_ and to ignore God's principles for living.

“Look out for number 1.

“Do your own thing”

“If it feels good, do it - regardless of what God says about it.”

“It's my life and I'll do what I please.”

**THE BIBLE CALLS THIS ATTITUDE \_\_\_\_\_**

*Isaiah 53:6 (ESV) All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.*

*1 John 1:8 (ESV) If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.*

**Sin breaks our close relationship with God. It causes us to fear God and try to live our lives outside his will.**

*Isaiah 59:2 (ESV)*

*your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God,*

*Romans 3:23 (ESV) for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,*

**When our relationship to God is not right, it causes \_\_\_\_\_ in every area of our lives—marriage, career, relationships, finances, etc.**

**WHEN PEOPLE HAVE PROBLEMS, THEY OFTEN TRY MANY DIFFERENT WAYS OF COPING BEFORE THEY TURN TO GOD.**

*Proverbs 16:25 (ESV)*

*There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way to death.*

**Even when we know that our deepest need is God, we often try the wrong ways of getting to know him:**

- “My mother was a Christian”
- “It doesn't matter what you believe, just be sincere”
- “I'll give up all my bad habits, first
- “I'll work real hard and earn it”
- “I'll be religious and go to church”
- The church is full of hypocrites.”

### III. WHAT IS THE SOLUTION?

*John 14:6 (ESV) Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.*

God Himself came to earth as a human being to bring us back into a love relationship with himself. If any other way would have worked, Jesus Christ would not have had to come and die for our sins. The way is the person, Jesus!

\_\_\_\_\_ has taken care of our sin problem.

*Romans 6:23 (ESV) For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

Jesus lived the life we should have lived and died the death that we should die.

**God did this for us because He loves us and wants us to be restored to right relationship with him.**

*Romans 5:8 (ESV) but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.*

*1 Timothy 2:5 (ESV) For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,*

God has already done his part to restore his relationship to him. He took the initiative. Now He waits for each of us to individually accept what he has done.

**Although we have offended God, Christ Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ us to God.**

*2 Corinthians 5:17-18 (ESV) Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation;*

#### IV. WHAT DOES GOD WANT ME TO DO?

1. \_\_\_\_\_ that God has not been first place in your life and ask him to forgive your sins.

*1 John 1:9 (ESV) If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*

2. \_\_\_\_\_ that Jesus died to pay for your sins and he rose again and is alive today.

*Romans 10:9 (ESV) because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.*

*Acts 4:12 (ESV) And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."*

3. \_\_\_\_\_ God's free gift of Salvation, Don't try to earn it.

*Ephesians 2:8-10 (ESV) For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.*

**Our relationship to God is not restored by anything we do, but on the basis of what Jesus already did for us!**

4. \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus Christ to come into your life and be the Director /Manager ("Lord") of your life.

*John 1:12-13 (ESV) But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.*

*Revelation 3:20 (ESV) Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me.*

**You can take these steps by praying a simple prayer of commitment to God:**

*“Dear Jesus, thank you for making me and loving me; even when I’ve ignored you and gone my own way. I realize I need you in my life and I’m sorry for my sins. I ask you to forgive me. Thank you for dying on the cross for me. Please help me understand it more. As much as I know how. I want to follow you from now on. Please come into my life and make me a new person inside. I accept your gift of Salvation. Please help me grow now as a Disciple of Jesus.”*

***Romans 10:13 (ESV) For “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”***



## THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING BAPTIZED

### I. WHY SHOULD I BE BAPTIZED?

1. To follow the example set by \_\_\_\_\_

*Mark 1:9 (ESV) In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan.*

2. Because Christ \_\_\_\_\_ it.

*Matthew 28:19-20 (ESV) Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”*

*Acts 18:8 (ESV) And many of the Corinthians hearing Paul believed and were baptized.*

### II. WHAT IS THE MEANING OF BAPTISM?

1. It illustrates Christ’s \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_

*1 Corinthians 15:3-4 (ESV) Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,*

*Colossians 2:12 (ESV) having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the powerful working of God, who raised him from the dead.*

2. It illustrates my \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ.

*2 Corinthians 5:17 (ESV) Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.*

*Romans 6:4 (ESV) We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.*

*John 3:3-5 (ESV) Jesus answered him, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God.” Nicodemus said to him, “How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother’s womb and be born?” Jesus answered, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.*

3. It illustrates my \_\_\_\_\_ / \_\_\_\_\_ as a Believer.

*Acts 22:16 (ESV) And now why do you wait? Rise and be baptized and wash away your sins, calling on his name.'*

*Titus 3:5 (ESV) He saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit.*

Baptism does not “save” you, only your faith in Christ does that. Baptism is like a wedding ring - it’s the outward symbol of the commitment you made with you heart. Baptism doesn’t make you a believer - it shows that you already believe.

*Ephesians 2:8-10 (ESV) For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.*

### III. WHY BE BAPTIZED BY IMMERSION?

1. Baptisms in the New Testament were by \_\_\_\_\_.

*Acts 8:38-39 (ESV) ... they both went down into the water, Philip and the eunuch, and he baptized him. And when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord carried Philip away, ..., and went on his way rejoicing.*

The Greek word for BAPTIZE means TO \_\_\_\_\_

**baptizō**; to dip. Immerse, submerge for a religious purpose, to overwhelm, saturate, baptize The Complete Word Study Dictionary – New Testament.

**Martin Luther** ... “I would have those who are to be Baptized to be entirely immersed, as the word imports and the mystery signifies.”

**John Calvin** ... “The word baptize signifies immerse. It is certain that immersion was the practice of the ancient church.”

**John Wesley** ... “Buried with him, alludes to Baptizing by immersion according to the customs of the first church.”

#### IV. WHO SHOULD BE BAPTIZED?

Every one who has \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ.

*Acts 8:12 (ESV) But when they believed Philip as he preached good news about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.*

At CACC, we wait until our children are old enough to believe and understand the true meaning of baptism before we baptize them.

Some churches practice a “baptism of confirmation” for children. The ceremony is intended to be a covenant between parents and God on behalf of the child. The parents promise to raise their child in the faith until the child is old enough to make his own personal confession of Christ. This custom began about 500 AD.

This is different from the baptism talked about in the Bible which was only for those who believe. The purpose is to publicly confess your personal commitment to Christ. At CACC, it is a membership requirement.

#### V. WHEN SHOULD I BE BAPTIZED?

**As soon as you have believed!**

*Acts 2:41 (ESV) So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls.*

*Acts 8:35-36 (ESV) Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning with this Scripture he told him the good news about Jesus. And as they were going along the road they came to some water, and the eunuch said, “See, here is water! What prevents me from being baptized?” eunuch went down to the water and Phillip baptized him.” Acts 8:35-38*

There is no reason to delay. As soon as you have decided to receive Christ into your life, you can should be baptized. If you wait till you are “Perfect,” you’ll never feel “good enough”

### **Can my family be baptized together?**

**YES!** If each family member understands fully the meaning of baptism, and each one has put his/her trust in Christ for Salvation, We encourage families to be baptized at the same time. It is a wonderful expression of commitment. Young children who wish to be baptized are asked to meet with the minister to children for a pre-baptism conversation,

However, it is important to remember that baptism is a personal statement of faith, not a family tradition. It is usually not wise to delay your baptism while waiting on other family members to accept Christ, particularly children. This puts an undue pressure on them, and delays your obedience.

### **What should I wear when I am baptized?**

Women should wear shorts and top or a “mu–mu” style dress rather than a swimsuit. You will be wearing a white baptismal gown that can be some what transparent when wet. Bring a towel and a change of clothes and a plastic bag for your wet clothes. You will meet in the upstairs of the education wing just south of the sanctuary. There are changing rooms up there and some deacons will assist you with any questions.

### **Will I have to say anything?**

You will be asked, “Are you here to proclaim your trust in Christ?” You will be expected to say, “Yes.” And you will have the opportunity to share more if you desire. But you are not expected to say anything more than “Yes.”

### **Special Note?**

**Any Member of the church you desire can perform the baptism.**

**Under special circumstances we can arrange for alternate baptismal methods.**

## THE MEANING OF COMMUNION

Jesus never asked disciples to remember his birth. But he did instruct them to remember his death and resurrection and his coming again. The Lord's supper is an object lesson that represents a great spiritual truth for believers.

*1 Corinthians 11:17-26 (NIV2011)*

*In the following directives I have no praise for you, for your meetings do more harm than good. In the first place, I hear that when you come together as a church, there are divisions among you, and to some extent I believe it. No doubt there have to be differences among you to show which of you have God’s approval. So then, when you come together, it is not the Lord’s Supper you eat, for when you are eating, some of you go ahead with your own private suppers. As a result, one person remains hungry and another gets drunk. Don’t you have homes to eat and drink in? Or do you despise the church of God by humiliating those who have nothing? What shall I say to you? Shall I praise you? Certainly not in this matter! For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, “This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.” In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.” For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes.*

We encourage you to practice COMMUNION at every meal.

We encourage families, groups of friends, small groups and individuals to practice COMMUNION on a regular basis.

We try to have Communion a central part of every meal gathering at the church and on irregular occasions in the Worship Celebration.

Jesus is the Savior and Lord. He was born of the virgin Mary. Being fully God and fully man. He lived a sinless life and offered himself as the perfect sacrifice for the sins of all people and dying on the cross. He was raised from the dead after three days to prove his power over sin and death. He ascended to heaven and will return someday to the earth to reign as King of kings and Lord of lords.

### 3. About GOD THE \_\_\_\_\_

The Holy spirit is co-equal with the Father and the Son. He is present in the world to make people aware of their need for Jesus. He lives in every believer from the moment of salvation. He is the Helper and Comforter and Counselor for every Disciple. He is the Disciple's source of power for living, wisdom, spiritual truth and guidance. He empowers the believer for service in the kingdom and family of God. Disciples of Jesus are instructed to live in the Spirit and to be filled with the Spirit.

### 4. About THE \_\_\_\_\_

The Bible is inspired by God the Holy Spirit. It is an infallible revelation to man through men. It is our supreme authority and is sufficient as our only rule of faith and practice.

John 5:39; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; Hebrews 4:12

### 5. About \_\_\_\_\_

We are made in God's image. We were designed to be like him in character. People are the supreme object in God's creation. All of us are marred by our disobedience toward God. This is called "Sin." People have a "sinful" nature which separates us from God and causes many problems in our lives. All people are to be treated and honored as people created in His image. We are in the process of transformation or restoring the marred image/nature of God through the power of the Holy Spirit

Genesis 1:26-27; Psalm 8:3-6; Isaiah 53:6; Romans 3:23; Isaiah 59:1-2; 2 Corinthians 3:17

### 6. About \_\_\_\_\_

Salvation is God's free gift to us but we must accept it. We can never make up for our sin by self-improvement, good intentions or good works. Only by trusting in Jesus Christ as God's offer of forgiveness can anyone be saved from sin's penalty. When we turn from our self ruled life and turn to Jesus in faith, we are saved. Eternal life begins the moment one receives Christ into his life by faith, demonstrated by repentance, confession, forgiveness, and submission to Christ as Lord.

Romans 5:1, 6:23; Ephesians 2:8-10; John 1:12, 14:6; Titus 3:5; Galatians 3:26

### 7. About \_\_\_\_\_

We were created to exist forever. We will either exist eternally separated from God by sin, or eternally with God through repentance, forgiveness and salvation. To be eternally separated from God is hell. To be with God eternally is to be in heaven eternally. Heaven and hell are real places of eternal existence.

## OUR LIFESTYLE STATEMENT

### What we practice

Beliefs are not worth much unless they are translated into actions. Based upon what the Bible teaches, we are committed to living out the following realities:

#### 1. THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF JESUS Spirit - led living

The only way to live a Disciple's life is through God's power. We seek to practice a daily surrendering, abiding, infilling and dependence upon the Holy Spirit to enable us to do what is right and to accomplish the work of the kingdom of this world.

***John 15:5 (ESV) I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.***

#### 2. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Scripture

Since the scriptures are the only completely reliable and truthful authority, we accept the Bible as our manual for living. Our first question when faced with a problem is "What is God's heart and mind on this matter?" God's heart and mind are best expressed through scriptures. Therefore, we practice daily Bible reading, Bible study, and Bible memorization. The Bible is the basis for all we believe.

***2 Timothy 3:16-17 (ESV) All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.***

#### 3. The \_\_\_\_\_ of every Believer

The Bible teaches that every Disciple is called to full time ministry, regardless of his/her vocation. Every believer is a minister. Every believer has direct approach to God through prayer and the right of private interpretation of scripture.

***1 Peter 2:9 (ESV) But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.***

#### 4. Baptism for \_\_\_\_\_

Baptism is a symbolic act of initiation for believers followers of Jesus. We practice Baptism by immersion under water, because we believe this is the way Jesus was Baptized and the way the Bible commands.

***Colossians 2:12 (ESV) having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the powerful working of God, who raised him from the dead.***

**5. A \_\_\_\_\_ Church Membership**

You can only be a member through confession in Jesus Christ as Lord and savior demonstrated by Believers Baptism. You may transfer from another evangelical church if you were baptized. If you are already a believer and previously Baptized we will accept you on your personal statement of Discipleship experience.

*Romans 10:9-10 (ESV) because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.*

**6. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the local church**

Christ is recognized as the head of the church. No person, group or religious organization holds control over the church. We recognize the value of associating, cooperating and maintaining fellowship with other churches. We value independence and inter-dependence. We value the church as a self governing organism and organization, independent from any denominational control.

*Colossians 1:18 (ESV) And he is the head of the body, the church.*

**7. The spiritual \_\_\_\_\_ of Believers**

Anyone who claims Jesus Christ as their Lord and savior is our brother and sister in Christ. We are family. We seek to be in unity with what God is doing in the life and fellowship of other believers.

*John 17:23 (ESV) I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.*

**8. The \_\_\_\_\_ of church and state**

Believers were fundamentally instrumental in the democratic formation of our nation and principle that the government should in no way promote or restrict any religious group. We affirm this principle. We encourage people to be involved in government, but we don't want to use the government to further the cause of Christ or any other religious beliefs.

*Romans 13:1 (ESV) Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God.*

We encourage everyone to practice tithing for support of God's body, the Church. We recognize that giving 10% of our income is a biblical standard of giving. We practice this as members and as a church. 10% of our tithes and offerings go to missions outside of our church for evangelism.

***Leviticus 27:30 (ESV) "Every tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land or of the fruit of the trees, is the LORD's; it is holy to the LORD.***

It is the responsibility of every believer to share the Good News with those which God brings us into relationship. We practice sharing about Christ and inviting friends to church. We speak blessing on every one we meet. We support missions work to unsaved peoples throughout the world. We support International Ministries and Transformation Ministries and a variety of local and foreign missions.

***Matthew 28:19-20 (ESV) Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."***

***Luke 10:2-9 (ESV) And he said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest. Go your way; behold, I am sending you out as lambs in the midst of wolves. Carry no moneybag, no knapsack, no sandals, and greet no one on the road. Whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace be to this house!' And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest upon him. But if not, it will return to you. And remain in the same house, eating and drinking what they provide, for the laborer deserves his wages. Do not go from house to house.
